A number of NWWWS Signature Members have graciously volunteered to critique photos and slides of paintings done by our members. All you have to do is fill out the form below, send it along with your photos and we will forward them to one or two Signature Member critiquers.

This service will be provided free of charge, but limited to one painting per member for this first round. Future submittal rounds will be announced in the Hot Press newsletter and on the NWWWS website.

Because the ability of the Signature Member to offer a useful critique will be affected by the quality of the photo provided, it is important that the photo be a clear, accurate image of the painting.

So that other members can learn from these critiques as well, we plan to publish some of the results in the Hot Press and/or on our website. These critiques are meant to help members improve their paintings. This is not a guarantee that you will be accepted into shows, but it should help you improve your work. If you do not want your name used in the newsletter or on the website, you may indicate your wish on the form.
