

GEORGE POLITIS SUPPLIES LIST: NOVEMBER 11, 2023

PAPER:

Watercolor paper or block you prefer. (I will use mostly Cold Pressed Paper. One of these brands — Arches, Baohong, Saunders)

Suggested size: Quarter sheet or a little larger

BRUSHES:

Your preferred brushes (I use Escoda brushes, but you use the ones you would be more familiar with). I mostly use round brushes, No 6-10.

A small one i.e. No. 2-3 (or a rigger) for details.

A flat brush (1 inch would be ok for our size of paintings).

A toothbrush (for spattering)

COLORS: (I use Daniel Smith watercolors, but other artist grade pigments are fine.)

Ochres/Yellows

- Quinacridone Gold (or Aussie Red Gold).
- Quinacridone Burnt Orange

Orange/Reds

- Mayan Orange
- Pyrrol Scarlet

Blues

- Cerulean Blue
- Mayan Dark Blue

Greens

- Cascade Green
- Perylene

Purples

- Moonglow (Beautiful diffusion)
- Imperial Purple

Granulating colors

- Piemontite Genuine
- Burnt Tiger's Eye.
- Bloodstone.

Earth colors

- Burnt Sienna
- Lunar Black
