

HIGH FLOW

Extremely versatile, pigment-based paint with an ink-like consistency.


- Highly pigmented acrylic paint with a thin, ink-like consistency.
- Great for refillable markers and airbrush.
- Palette includes Iridescent and Fluorescent colors.
- Compatible with other GOLDEN Acrylic Colors and Mediums.



Because of the additional water required to achieve the consistency needed for stain or wash, Heavy Body Colors may become more diluted than the same Fluid Colors diluted to the same consistency.

Creativity & Control

The concept of QoR Watercolors does not end with colors. Like every product that comes from GOLDEN, the idea of equipping artists to realize their creative vision inspires our products. QoR Mediums help extend and enhance the creative range and control of watercolors, whether the objective is modulating colors through lifting with Lift Aid™, extending colors to their most distant point with Watercolor Medium, or unleashing the flow of colors with Synthetic Ox Gall.

Where our mediums carry forward traditional painting techniques QoR Grounds bring a totally new wave of expression to watercolors. Watercolor Ground quickly transforms nearly any surface into an absorbant bright while painting surface similar to hortpress papers, while Cold Press Ground and Light Dimensional Ground transform surfaces with texture ranging from toothy cold-press style surfaces to lustrous modeled surfaces that you design. Finally, to preserve a paper or ground from color. Masking Fluid is a removable barrier that helps create hard edge effects.



MOLDING PASTES

- Light Molding Paste

 Offlers great flexibility on carwas.

 Holds stiff peaks for highly textured surfaces.

 Blends well with Fluid and Heavy Body colors.

 A highly absorbent ground when dry, good for textural watercolor effects.

 Weighs over 50% less than Molding Paste.

- Molding Paste

 Dries to a slightly gray, hard finish.

 Use for creating texture, much like frescoed
- walls.
 Mixed with color, it will create a tint.

- Coarse Molding Paste

 Use as a surface for Fluid Acrylic color washes or as a ground for drawing media.

 Apply thinly for a unique translucent, frost-like effect.

 Dries to a warm white color and a stiff but flexible film, with a tooth like filme sampleper.

- Hard Molding Paste


 Dries to an extremely hard, opaque film.
 Useful for creating tough, durable finishes for smooth or textured surfaces.

 The dried film can be carved with hand or power tools.

All GOLDEN varnish have UVLS (Ultra Violet Light Stabilizers) and are <u>removable</u>. We produce two types of varnish: mineral spirit based (MSA) in brush-on or spray, and polymer (waterborne) brush-on varnish.
