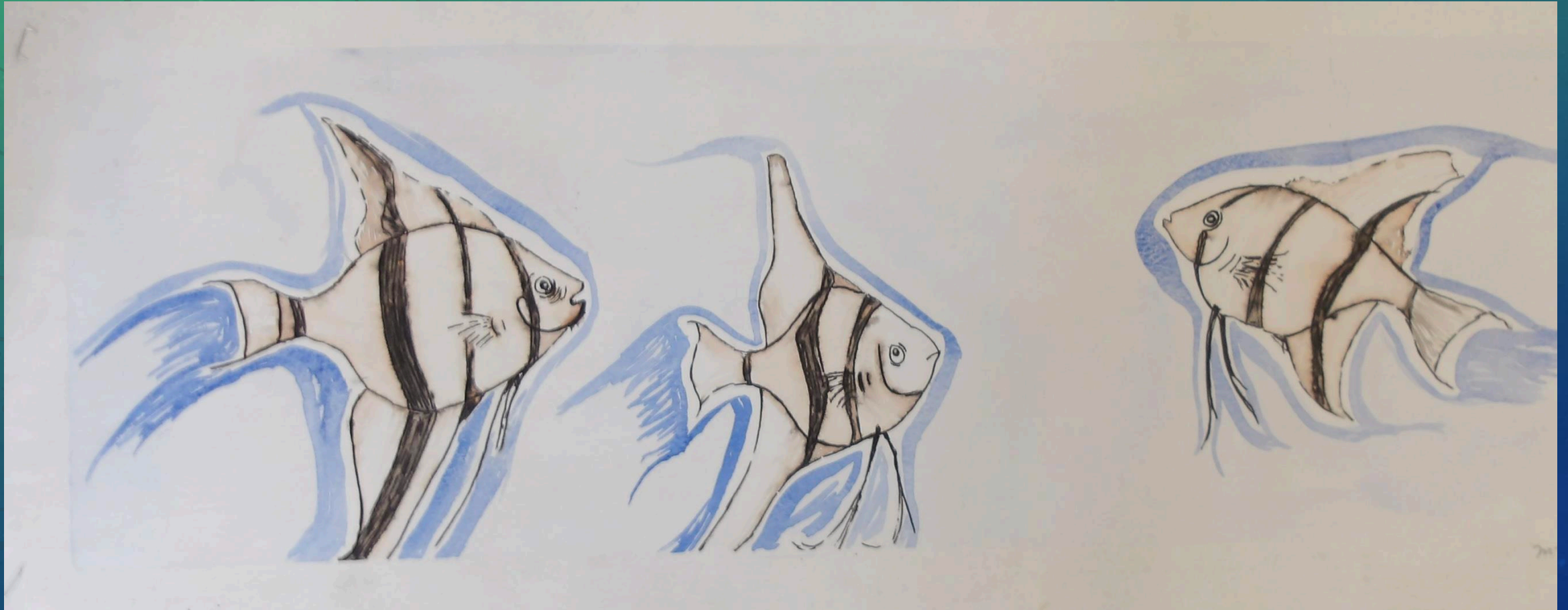


NWWF ART FOR KIDS 2024 REPORT
